


## **State Route 25 Deficiency Improvement Project**



## **Project Description**

The San Benito Route 25 Deficiency Improvement Project (05-1F430) is a safety project that will address deficiencies identified along the alignment of the Route 25 Bypass in the City of Hollister, between Sunnyslope / Tres Pinos Road and San Felipe Road.

The project will improve alignment consistency, traffic flow, and safety. Improvements will include: constructing a curve correction, widening shoulders, flattening and seeding embankment slopes, improving drainage facilities, adding sidewalks and reconstructing curb ramps, and replacing signal loop detectors.

The project construction was awarded to Granite Rock Company.
