Subject: Senate Bill 1 State of Good Repair Program Funds for Transit

#### Recommendations:

**ADOPT** Resolution 2021-04 Approving Projects for Funding and Authorizing the Executive Director to Apply for and Accept FY 2021-22 California State of Good Repair Program Funds Totaling \$96,116.

#### **Summary:**

The LTA is eligible to receive a total of \$96,116 in State of Good Repair funds for FY 2021-22. Adoption of Resolution 2021-04 will approve the projects identified for funding.

#### **Financial Considerations:**

COG and LTA are eligible to receive a total of \$96,116 of FY 2021-22 SGR Program funds for eligible transit projects. There is no local match required.

#### **Background:**

With the signing of Senate Bill 1, many new funding sources were established including the SGR Program for transit operators to fund eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation and capital projects. Funds are distributed using the State Transit Assistance formulas, so both COG, as the RTPA, and LTA, as the transit operator, receive allocations in this program. For this reason, Caltrans is requiring both COG and LTA to submit Board resolutions approving the project list.

#### **Staff Analysis:**

After reviewing LTA's adopted Short Range/Long Range Transit Plan and 2018 Transit Asset Management Plan, staff has prepared a list of eligible SGR Program projects detailed in Exhibit A of Resolution 2021-04. At this time, staff recommends the LTA Board approve the list of eligible projects for the allocation request that was due September 1, 2021. Additionally, staff recommends that the Board authorize the Executive Director to apply for and accept the SGR Program funds for the list of projects when distributed by Caltrans.

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors adopt Resolution 2021-04 to be eligible to receive a total of \$96,116 for FY 2021-22 SGR Program funds.

WHEREAS, the Council of San Benito County Governments (COG) is the designated Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA) for San Benito County, pursuant to Government Code section 29532(b); and

WHEREAS, the San Benito County Local Transportation Authority (LTA) is the designated Consolidated Transportation Services Agency (CTSA) for San Benito County, pursuant to Government Code section 15975; and

WHEREAS, as the designated RTPA for San Benito County, COG is an eligible project sponsor and may receive State Transit Assistance (STA) funding from the State of Good Repair Account (SGR) for transit projects calculated pursuant to the distribution formulas in Public Utilities Code (PUC) section 99313 based on the certification of population from the California Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, as the designated CTSA for San Benito County, LTA is an eligible project sponsor and may receive STA funding from the SGR Account for transit projects calculated pursuant to the distribution formulas in PUC section 99314 based on the qualifying revenue amounts for each STA-eligible operator determined from annual reports submitted to the State Controller pursuant to PUC section 99243; and

WHEREAS, COG and LTA have identified a list of transit projects in San Benito County, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, to be funded through the FY 2021-22 SGR Account; and

**WHEREAS**, the transit projects to be submitted for FY 2021-22 SGR funding total \$96,116, to be allocated to COG and LTA pursuant to the distribution formulas in PUC sections 99313 and 99314; and

WHEREAS, COG's portion of the FY 2021-22 SGR allocation is \$94,555, as determined pursuant to the distribution formula in PUC section 99313; and

WHEREAS, LTA's portion of the FY 2021-22 SGR allocation is \$1,561, as determined pursuant to the distribution formula in PUC section 99314; and

WHEREAS, COG has designated LTA as the lead agency for the SGR funded transit projects identified in Exhibit A, to be funded in part through COG's SGR allocations, and has indicated its desire, upon receipt of SGR funds for those projects, to allocate COG's share of SGR funds to LTA, to administer the projects as the CTSA for San Benito County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Benito County Local Transportation Authority shall be the lead agency for the SGR funded transit projects identified in Exhibit A, to be funded in part through COG's SGR allocations and in part through LTA's SGR allocations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the San Benito County Local Transportation Authority hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the San Benito County Local Transportation Authority to apply for and accept SGR funds awarded by Caltrans for transit projects in San Benito County for FY 2021-22, and to execute the application and related materials, grant agreement and amendments, and all other documents necessary for the application submittal and acceptance of SGR funds awarded by Caltrans for transit projects in San Benito County, for and on behalf of the Council of Governments and Local Transportation Authority.

Subject: August 2021 County Express Service Changes

#### **Recommendation:**

**RECEIVE** Presentation on August 2021 County Express Service Changes.

#### **Summary:**

Staff continues to monitor the response from the agency and its public transportation service contractors, MV Transportation and Jovenes de Antaño, to the COVID-19 pandemic. In August 2021, County Express, operated by MV Transportation, implemented service changes to adjust to shifting community needs.

#### **Financial Considerations:**

LTA receives funding for transit capital and operations through several sources, including Federal Transit Administration Sections 5310 and 5311, Transportation Development Act (TDA) Local Transportation Funds, State Transit Assistance, Senate Bill 1, and Measure G (local sales tax measure).

Additionally, in response to COVID-19, LTA is anticipated to received federal financial support of approximately \$2 million through the passing of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA). The amount LTA can expect as part of the passing of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) is still to be announced. All relief funds are distributed to LTA through the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 and 5311 grants administered by Caltrans. No local match is required.

#### **Background:**

Beginning February 2020, LTA and its public transportation service contractors, MV Transportation and Jovenes de Antaño, began to make operational modifications to keep the community safe when riding its San Benito County Express and Specialized Transportation services. Initial changes included reducing service, increasing cleaning, requiring facial coverings, and social distancing. LTA staff initiated these changes coordinating activities with the contractors, San Benito County (SBC) Office of Emergency Services, SBC Public Health, and the Cities.

#### **Staff Analysis:**

As the community's transit needs have been shifting in response to COVID-19, County Express implemented service changes in August 2021. Currently, the following County Express services are available:

- County Express Tripper weekday fixed route service in the City of Hollister during peak school travel times, open to students and the general public
- County Express On-Demand weekday on-demand, shared-ride, public transit service within the City of Hollister; riders can book a trip through our app or call dispatch
- Paratransit trips scheduled through dispatch within the Paratransit service area when County Express Tripper is in service for ADA-certified riders
- Dial-a-Ride trips scheduled through dispatch outside the City of Hollister but within the Dial-a-Ride service area, open to the general public seven days a week
- Intercounty Caltrain, Gavilan, and Greyhound shuttle service from Hollister and San Juan Bautista to Gavilan College and the Gilroy Transit Center, open to the general public seven days a week

During the August meeting, staff will further present on these County Express services.
