## **ALL LANES TO REMAIN OPEN NEXT WEEK AT ROUNDABOUT PROJECT ON STATE ROUTES 25/156**

### *UPDATE #4*

SAN BENITO COUNTY – Next week, the temporary movement of roundabout construction work to just off the roadway, at the intersection of State Routes 25 and 156, will result in all lanes remaining open.

Necessary fill work at one of the corners of the intersection off the roadway is to result in the cancellation of lane closures.

Lane closures at the intersection of State Routes 25 and 156 are expected to resume the week of Monday June 27.

An update will be provided next week detailing the reactivation of lane closures associated with this project for the week of Monday June 27.

The contractor for this \$10.7 million construction project is Graniterock of San Jose, CA and the project is scheduled to be completed in April 2023.
