ALL LANES OPEN NEXT WEEK AT ROUNDABOUT PROJECT ON STATE ROUTES 25/156

UPDATE #3

SAN BENITO COUNTY – The temporary movement next week of project work to just off the roadway at the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of State Routes 25 and 156 will result in all lanes being open.

Starting Friday June 10, through Sunday June 19, necessary fill work at one of the corners of the intersection, off the roadway, will result in the cancellation of all lane closures at this intersection.

An update will be provided next week detailing the reactivation of lane closures which are expected to return the week of Monday June 20.

The contractor for this \$10.7 million construction project is Graniterock of San Jose, CA and the project is scheduled to be completed in April 2023.
