

SBCOG Executive Director Binu Abraham called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m.

5. **MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

Abraham Prado announced that the County will be hosting a Community Workshop on their Housing Element Update and discussion of the General Plan, and impact fees on May 22, 2024, at 6:00 PM at the Paine’s Restaurant banquet room.

Steve Loupe announced that the Union Road Bridge Project construction is on schedule, with the new bridge set to open in September

Heather Adamson reported that the upcoming AMBAG Board agenda will be extensive, addressing federal fund allocation for Carbon Reduction Program projects, the final Complete Streets Policy, an update of the draft 2026 Regional Growth Forecast, and discussion on the Public Draft Monterey Bay Natural and Working Lands Climate Mitigation and Resiliency Study- a Sustainable Agriculture and Conservation (SALC) Grant from the California Department of Conservation.

William Via joined the TAC meeting at 2:08 p.m.

Binu Abraham reported that the SBCOG Board has requested an update on the utilization of Measure G funds.

7. Receive Update on the Status of the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) as prepared by the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments - Condon/ AMBAG

William Condon with AMBAG, provided an overview of the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) process and schedule. Mr. Condon noted that the deadline to submit projects for the MTIP is May 17, 2024. The final MTIP will go before the AMBAG Board for approval in September.

Don Reynolds joined the TAC meeting at 2:30 p.m.

There was no public comment.

**8. Bi-annual State Highway Operations and Protection Program – Ochoa/ Caltrans D5**

- a. Receive an Update on the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) for District 5.
- b. Receive the Caltrans District 5 Bi-annual Project List Communication Booklet for San Benito County 2024.

Jimmy Ochoa with Caltrans District 5 provided an overview of the State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP) and the Bi-Annual Project List Communication Booklet and answered questions from the TAC.

There was a question about the distribution of the Caltrans D5 Bi-annual Project List booklet. Mr. Ochoa noted that while Caltrans sends the booklet to SBCOG for distribution to partner agencies, he will also distribute it directly to the RTP's and MPO's to ensure broader access. An updated version of the booklet will be released in August.

Mr. Ochoa emphasized the importance of communication with Caltrans regarding any project interests, such as complete streets, transit facilities, climate change issues, or other concerns. Contact Jill Leal at Caltrans D5 and they will do their best to address it. He stressed the need to share your ideas early to prevent surprises when projects are already in the pipeline.

There was no public comment.

**9. Receive Measure G Update – Aceves**

Norma Aceves provided an update on Measure G. She noted that effective July 2024, Measure G funding for local agencies' street and road maintenance will be paused for ten years, with all resources directed towards the Highway 25 priority project. Staff is actively reviewing this funding strategy and will provide updates on any plan adjustments.

Binu Abraham stated that SBCOG is focused on minimizing the impact on local streets and roads.

Ms. Aceves noted a correction to the Power-point presentation for Measure G 2018-Q3 FY 23/24. The allocated amount for Road Improvements was listed as \$12.6 million, but the correct amount is \$35.6 million.

There was no public comment.

**10. Receive Update on Highway 25 Conversion Project – Abraham**

Binu Abraham provided an update on the Highway 25 Conversion Project. She provided an overview of the project development, and some of the challenges, next steps and answered

questions from the TAC. Currently, the project is in the Project Approval and Environmental Documentation (PAED) phase.

There being no further business to discuss, William Via motioned to adjourn the Technical Advisory Committee meeting at 3:15 p.m. Motion seconded by Heather Adamson.

### Recommendation:

**RECEIVE** an update on the Transportation Project List for inclusion in the 2050 San Benito Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

### Summary:

The Council of San Benito County Governments (SBCOG) staff will present an overview of the Transportation Project List and outline the next steps for its finalization. SBCOG staff is seeking feedback from the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) on the 2050 RTP Draft Transportation Project List.

### Background/ Discussion:

The 2050 San Benito RTP is a long-range transportation plan that is developed and updated by SBCOG. The plan outlines a vision for transportation priorities and investments within the San Benito region, considering the role of transportation and how it can support economic, environmental, and quality-of-life goals. All Regional Transportation Planning Agencies in California, including SBCOG, are required to complete the RTP to ensure local projects remain eligible for state and federal funding.

State law requires the RTP be updated every four years, to ensure that the RTP identifies the most current transportation needs and offers strategies to address those needs. The RTP update serves as an opportunity to ask the public, community leaders, and other agencies how they would like to see the future of transportation unfold in the San Benito region.

A critical element of the RTP is the Project List component; the RTP Project List includes projects and programs needed to operate, maintain, and improve the transportation system in the San Benito Region. TAC is being asked to review and comment on the draft Transportation Project List (Attachment 1). The list consists of planned local and state roadways, bicycle and pedestrian, transit, airport, among other transportation programs. Upon the completion of TAC comments



SBCOG staff will provide direction regarding the finalization of the Project List. Once finalized the Draft Project List will be presented to the SBCOG Board of Directors. The 2050 RTP is anticipated to be adopted by the SBCOG Board in June of 2026.

**Financial Impact:**

The completion of a Regional Transportation Plan is a requirement of all Regional Transportation Planning Agencies in California, such as SBCOG, for local projects to be eligible for state and federal funding.
